## Homework Challenges

Go on a number hunt! What numbers can you see around the house or on a walk around the local area? You could look at door numbers, number plates, food packaging, clocks, magazines and books. You could take photos or draw pictures of the numbers you find. Try to find the numerals 0,1,2,3, and 4.

Perform a song we have been singing in class such as 'Heads, Shoulders, neck and Toes' to someone at home.

Go on a 'listening' walk around your local area. Listen carefully to the different sounds that you hear. You could take photographs or draw pictures of the different things you hear.

Share a Story with an adult at home, discuss what happens in the story and your favourite characters. You could draw a picture of the book or bring it in to share with your friends at story-time

Play a board game or complete a jigsaw with some family members, ensuring that you take turns .
